Texas State Snipe Championship

October 12-13, 2024

White Rock Lake, Dallas, Texas

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:

Corinthian Sailing Club, Dallas, Texas (441 E. Lawther Drive, Dallas, TX, www.cscsailing.org) and Snipe Fleet 001 in co-operation with the Snipe Class International Racing Association (SCIRA-www.snipeusa.com)

RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

The SCIRA Rules of Conduct for Conducting National and Local Regattas, and the Deed of Gift will apply.

The US Sailing prescriptions will apply. In case of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, The Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

SUSTAINABILITY:

Please bring reusable water bottles. We will have a limited supply of reusable bottles for out-of-town competitors to borrow for the weekend. We will provide only a highly limited supply of single-use water bottles. We will provide an ample supply of water for the refillable bottles.

ADVERTISING:

Advertising is permitted per Snipe Class rules.

ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY:

This regatta is open to SCIRA registered boats and SCIRA Member skippers who are in good standing with SCIRA for the current year subject to any Deed of Gift trophy restrictions. No skipper shall be eligible to enter unless they are verified to be a current member of SCIRA. The basis for verification of current membership and boat registration shall be the most current SCIRA-USA Membership and Boat Registration List as posted on the Snipeus.org web site and/or the SCIRA ON Line Data Base. SCIRA membership dues for the current year may be paid to Fleet 001 at time of boat registration. Crews need not be members of SCIRA, but the races will not count towards the award of SCIRA's Minneford Trophy unless both skipper and crew are SCIRA members.

MEASUREMENT:

All boats shall produce a valid measurement certificate or shall have one on file with SCIRA and are subject to measurement at any time at the reasonable discretion of the SCIRA Representative. All boats are required to have a current Class decal properly displayed, confirmation through the SCIRA website that boat registration for 2024 has been paid, or payment made at time of regatta registration for 2024 SCIRA registration.

WHITE ROCK LAKE LOCAL REQUIREMENT:

Local lake rules require one personal flotation device (“life jacket”) for each person in the boat as well as one additional throwable cushion. The cushion can be a third life jacket. **Inflatable life jackets are not permitted per Snipe Class Rules.**

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The Regatta Sailing Instructions are available online at dalsail.com and will be available at the regatta site at time of registration. They are also available via email request to laura@the-olearys.us

COURSES:

The courses to be sailed are the Class approved courses for National and Local regattas, or approved variants thereof, as published in the current SCIRA Official Rulebook and SCIRA web site and will be described in the Sailing Instructions. Such courses may be modified to account for local conditions. All races will be sailed on White Rock Lake, Dallas, Texas.

U and BLACK FLAG:

RRS Rule 30.3 and 30.4 shall not be used in this regatta.

SCORING:

The ISAF scoring system, Appendix A will be used, modified to add TLE (time limit expired). TLE shall be scored as one more than the last boat to finish within the allotted time. Any boat significantly behind the fleet on the last upwind leg may be directed by a race officer to abandon the leg and return to the starting line for the next race. Such boat will be scored points for its position (as determined by the race officer) at the time of such notice. 20% (DP) Penalty Score is available under certain circumstances. See the Sailing Instructions. This changes A11.

NUMBER OF RACES:

One race makes the regatta.

There will be no maximum number of races, except that no more than three races will be sailed on Saturday.

LOANER BOATS:

Loaner boats are available to members of Dallas Snipe Fleet 001, members of the Corinthian Sailing Club, and out of town visitors. **The deadline for Fleet 001 members to have priority for a loaner boat is September 9, 2024.** After that, loaner boats will be equally available to fleet members, CSC members and out-of-town competitors. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

PRIZES:

Prizes shall be awarded to the skipper and crew for the top five (5) places. Highly coveted prizes shall also be awarded for best costume and best dancer.

BOAT LAUNCHING AND BOAT/TRAILER ACCOMODATIONS:

The Corinthian Sailing Club can now accommodate hand launching from light trailers and beach dollies from two floating ramps inside the club facility near the North entrance. The North entrance has a double

gate and wide entrance ramp so bring your dolly. Empty trailers may be chained to trees. We suggest bringing a 10' chain. Alternatively, they be left at Gene Soltero's house.

HOUSING ACCOMODATIONS:

Limited housing with fleet members may be available. Please contact Laura O’Leary (laura@the-olearys.us) as early as possible if you seek housing with fleet members.

Regatta fees: Boat registration (includes skipper & crew beverages)
Regular registration: \$100¹
Late registration (after October 7, 2024): \$125
Extra Saturday dinner(s) (\$25 each)²

SCIRA fees & dues: Skipper & boat registration (for hull # _____) \$105
Skipper or crew without boat ownership \$30
*Charter insurance premium for regatta \$40

*Charter boat insurance deductible \$240 (Check payable to SCIRA-USA and will be returned if no damage to boat)

Loaner boat fees: No charge for loaner boats (including a decent set of practice sails)

Regatta sails fee: \$50 for the regatta to use a set of regatta quality sails

*Charter boat insurance is voluntary and may be purchased at registration. With insurance, the first \$240 of damage is the responsibility of the charterer. Without insurance 100% of any damage is the responsibility of the charterer.
